SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT

To the Superintending School Committee:

As required by law, I submit herewith, my annual report as Superintendent of your schools.

Mrs. Ida Roberts has again been our teacher this year and has continued her excellent work.

Standard Achievement tests were given the pupils and the results show that the school as a whole is up to average.

Health Programs and Safety Programs have been carried out throughout the year.

A considerable amount of work has been done in Music.

The Equalization Fund is somewhat larger this year and has enabled us to lengthen our school year to 36 weeks. This fund may be used for salaries, fuel, janitor service, conveyance, text books, and supplies. However, the two specific purposes mentioned in the law, are lengthening of the school year, and raising the standards of teachers. Therefore, a large part of the fund should be expended for these purposes.

The present Equalization Fund does not in any way constitute a local tax reduction possibility under the present law. The fund in accordance with the wording of the statute should be used to improve school facilities beyond those made possible through the regular appropriation of the Town.

The Equalization law which passed the legislature of 1937, but was defeated at a later Referendum, would have made possible a local reduction of taxes to a .0012 rate, but that is not possible with the limited amount provided for Equalization under the present law.

In order to participate in the Equalization Fund, the school rate and the municipal rate must be above the

average of that for the State. For the present year, the average school rate is .01270, while the average municipal rate is .05732. The school rate for Roque Bluffs is .02429, the municipal rate .057.

In planning our Budget for next year, we have reckoned in the estimated Equalization Fund, because we are planning to have 36 weeks of school.

The following Budget will show what is necessary to appropriate.
