WARRANT

STATE OF MAINE

Washington, ss.

To Horace Preston, a Constable of the Town of Roque Bluffs, in the County of Washington and State of Maine,

GREETING:

In the name of the State of Maine you are hereby required to notify and warn the inhabitants of the Town of Roque Bluffs aforesaid, qualified by law to vote in town affairs, to assemble at the School House in the said town of Roque Bluffs, on the thirty-first day of March, A. D. 1941, at ten of the clock in the forenoon there and then to act upon the following articles, to wit:

- Article 1. To choose a moderator to preside over said meeting.
- Article 2. To choose a town clerk for the ensuing year.
- Article 3. To see if the town will vote to accept the report of the selectmen and other officers as printed.
- Article 4. To choose three selectmen.
- Article 5. To choose three assessors.
- Article 6. To choose one or more overseers of the poor.
- Article 7. To choose a town treasurer for the ensuing year.

- Article 8. To choose one member of the superintending school committee for three years.
- Article 9. To see if the town will vote to elect a road commissioner and if so, to elect the same and fix his compensation.
- Article 10. To fix the amount to be paid for the collection of taxes.
- Article 11. To choose a tax collector.
- Article 12. To choose all other necessary officers for the ensuing year.
- Article 13. To see what sum the town will raise for maintenance of improved state road under the provisions of Section 18 of Chapter 28 of the Revised Statutes of Maine, 1930.
- Article 14. To see if the town will vote to appropriate and raise the sum of Ten Dollars for the combatting of tuberculosis in Washington County, said sum to be expended by the Washington County Anti-Tuberculosis Association.
- Article 15. To see what sums of money the town will vote to raise for the following purposes: Contingent Fund; Highways and Bridges; Poor; Snow Removal; Schools; Repairs on School Buildings; and all and any other town charges for the year ensuing.
- Article 16. To see what sum the town will raise and appropriate for State Aid road construction (in addition to the amounts regularly raised for the care of ways, highways and bridges) under the provisions of Sec-

tion 19, Chapter 28, Revised Statutes of Maine, 1930, or under the provisions of Section 3, Chapter 229, Public Laws of Maine, 1937.

- Article 17—To see if the town will vote to raise a sum of money and how much for the advertising of the resources of Washington County under the provisions of Chapter 5, Section 82, of the Revised Statutes of Maine, 1930. Said sum to be expended by the Maine Publicity Bureau.
- Article 18. To see if the town will vote to raise a sum of money, and how much, for the cutting of bushes on the improved State Aid Road.
- Article 19. To see if the town will vote to raise a sum of money, to be not less than Fifty-eight Dollars, for the maintenance of improved Third Class Roads.
- Article 20. To see if the town will vote to borrow not exceeding Eleven Hundred Dollars upon the faith and credit of the town, during the municipal year 1941 and 1942 in anticipation of and to be paid from the amount to be collected from taxes of said municipal year. And if the town votes so to borrow to authorize and direct the treasurer to execute and deliver the negotiable interest bearing promissory note or notes of the town for the sums so borrowed.
- Article 21. To see if the town will vote to authorize the selectmen on behalf of the town to sell and dispose of any real estate acquir-

ed by the town for non-payment of taxes thereon, on such terms as they deem advisable, and to execute and deliver quit-claim deeds for such property.

Article 22. To see what compensation the town will vote to the Fire Warden for his services.

Article 23. To see what compensation the town will vote the Moderator for his services.

Article 24. To transact any other business that may properly and legally come before said meeting.

The selectmen hereby give notice that they will be in session at the School House at 8:30 A. M. on the day of said meeting, for the purpose of revising and correcting the list of voters.
