Report of the Superintendent of Schools.

To the Superintending School Committee and citizens of Lincolnville.

I hereby submit my annual report as superintendent of Schools.

I think on the whole our schools for the past year rank well compared with years past and with other towns of our size and ability.

Of the nine schools five have had the same teacher throughout the year. Two have had the same teacher for two consecutive terms and the other two, owing to unavoidable circumstances have had a change each term.

We have had three Normal graduates and one other teacher with Normal training. With one exception all our teachers have had previous experience and some of them have taught many years.

By the efforts of the teacher, pupils and parents, a nice globe has been placed in the Wiley school and a flag bought for the Youngtown school, without expense to the town and many other light repairs have been made in the different schools by the same process.

The old readers have been replaced by the Silver, Burdett series which I think is proving highly satisfactory.

In the coming year we shall need some new arithmetics and spellers but on the whole the book expense for the next year need not be very large.

In closing I wish to extend thanks to the Committee, teachers, pupils and parents for their hearty co-operation towards making the schools for the past year of the greatest value to the greatest number and for their assistance to me in the discharge of my duties.
