The grammar grades at Glenburn Center are in charge of Miss Frances Keyes. Miss Keyes is a teacher of experience and marked ability. The discipline, advancement and interest in the work has met with the approval of all.

Miss Marjorie Hatch is again in charge of the primary grades. This is her third year in the same school. Her work has always been satisfactory.

We were fortunate in securing the services of Mrs. Jennie Pierce for another year. Excellent progress has been made.

REPAIRS

During the summer vacation minor repairs were made. The lighting was very much improved by the interior painting done at W. Glenburn and the grammar building. The new primary building erected is very comfortable and convenient. It is nicely located and is one of the best buildings in Maine. It is properly lighted and heated, well equipped and sanitary.
