REPORT OF CHIEF ENGINEER FIRE DEPT

I herewith respectfully submit my report as Chief of the fire department for the past year. The department is in good condition with the exception of hose, whole number of feet 1800 of this only 1200 ft are of first class; the balance being more or less worn and strained. This department should have not less than 2000 feet of good servicable hose.

We have had nine (9) fire alarms as follows:— March 27 Alarm 8 p in Belonie Vaillancour, caused by lamp; total loss.

April 3 Alarm 9 pm Ceriase Ducas, cause defective chimney; total loss.

June 12 Alarm 1 p m Van Buren Lbr Mfg Co., cause Friction; slight damage.

July Alarm 11 p m Lock Up, cause unknown; considerable damage.

Oct 15 Alarm 3 p m August Viollette, cause unknown; small damage.

Dec Alarm 12 30 p m St Mary's College, cause ashes in barrel; considerable damage

Dec	Alarm 9 a m F J Parent potato house cause overheated stove pipe; small
Jan	damage. Alarm 6 p m John Parent house
	cause chimney; no damage
Jan	Alarm 10 30 p m Post office cause fire place; slight damage.

I would recommend the purchase of 400 feet of hose and about a dozen rubber coats and boots for this year.

The work on the State Road was done as the year before, under a contract with the State Highway Commissioner, and the superivision of engineers chosen by him.

The road improved was a continuance of work done in 1909 going toward the Keegan village.

This account includes the iron and wood railing on the fill of 1909, 550 feet of V drain and 1,175 feet of surfacing, making an average cost of 68 cents per foot.

We recommend that \$400 be raised for State Road.

TO FRED GERARD, A CONSTABLE OF THE TOWN OF VAN BUREN IN THE COUNTY OF AROOSTOOK.

GREETING:

In the name of the State of Maine, you are hereby required to notify and warn the Inhabitants of said Town of Van Buren, qualified by law to vote in town affairs, to assemble at Joseph Martin's Hall, so called, in said town of Van Buren, on Wednesday, the twentieth day of March, A. D. 1912, at nine o'clock in the forenoon, to act on the following articles to wit:—

- Art 1 To choose a moderator to preside at said meeting.
 - 2 To choose all necessary town officers for the ensuing year.
 - To see if the town will grant and raise such sums of money as may be necessary for the maintenance and support of schools and the poor, and the repair of roads and bridges, and to defray all other town charges for the year ensuing.
 - To see if the town will vote to elect one road Commissioner, or more, not exceeding three.
 - To see if the town will vote, "yes" or "no" upon the adoption of the provisions of chapter 112 of the Public Laws of Maine, for the year 1907, as amended by chapter 69, Public Laws of 1909, relating to the appropriations of money necessary to entitle the town to state aid for highways for the year 1912.
 - To see if the town will raise and appropriate in addition to the amount regularly raised and appropriated for the care of ways, highways and bridges, the sum of \$200.00 being the maximum amount which the town is allowed to raise under the provisions of chapter 112 of the public laws of Maine for the year 1907, as amended by chapter 69, public laws of 1909, also

- chapter 21, public laws of 1911, and chapter 183, public laws of 1911.
- To see what sum of money, if any, the town will vote, to be expended on a new road leading from the Duperre Bridge, so called, running in a southerly direction and following the Little Fork, so called, to the northerly line of Cyr Plantation.
- To see what sum of money, if any, the town will vote to be expended on a new road leading from the Allendale Road, so called, running in a southerly direction and following the south-westerly side of the land of the Bangor & Aroostook Railroad Company, upon which lies its track, to the Old Caribou Road, near the round house of the said company, on condition of the fulfilment of the promises of the petitioners.
- To see what sum of money, if any, the town will vote to complete the road leading from land of Cyrille Dubay to land of Vital F. Cyr.
- To see what sum of money, if any, the town will vote to raise to be expended for the purpose of extending a certain highway road leading from Alcide Marquis' land to land of Napoleon Rossignol and Antoine Madore.
- To see what sum of money, if any, the town will vote to raise and to be expended for the purpose of extending a certain highway road leading from the land of Letuce Parent to lots of land of Alexis B. Cyr and Paul P. Martin.
- 12 To see what sum of money the town will vote to raise for sidewalks.
- To see what sum of money the town will vote to raise, if any, for the purpose of building a sidewalk not less than five feet in width, on the south-westerly side of Main Street, in Van Buren Village, to connect with the sidewalk on the street leading from Main Street by the old C. F. Hammond's place or Hammond street, so called, and Burleigh Street or street leading to the Bangor & Aroostook Railroad Passenger Station.

- To see what sum of money the town will vote to raise for rent of Hydrants.
- To see what sum of money the town will vote to raise for lighting the streets of the village,
- To see what sum of money the town will vote to raise for the salary of the Superintendent of Schools.
- 17 To see what sum of money the town will vote to raise for the payment of the firemen.
- To see what sum of money the town will vote to raise, for the fire department, and for fire apparatus, and supplies.
- 19 To transact all other business.

The Selectmen will be in session at the place of meeting at 8 o'clock in the forenoon of the date of the meeting, to revise the list of voters.
