## Town Agent's Report

---

The only controversies which affect the town are with certain of its citizens.

One is the suit against J Adolphe Hebert in which the Auditor will make his report to the April term of the Supreme Court. This arose out of the practice of Mr. Hebert of drawing orders in the name of different persons and without their endorsement, obtaining checks from the town treasurer, which he did during his two terms as Selectman, to a very large amount. When requested, he refused or neglected to furnish vouchers for the same. Hence this suit. Mr. Hebert is required by law to do only what he should have done without being asked.

Two suits have been brought by the Van Buren Light & Power Company, claiming to have a contract with the town of Van Buren for lighting the streets of Van Buren village. As the charter under which said Company acts, distinctly authorizes the making of such a contract with the towns of Van Buren and Hamlin "by their Selectmen," and the contract on the very face of it shows that it was not made with the town by its "Selectmen," the contract is plainly void. Several other objections might be made, but this alone is sufficient to make the contract clearly void, as it is clearly unjust as well as improperly obtained. The attempt on the part of men who should have been the guardians of the interests of the town to bind the inhabitants for a period of fifteen years to an unreasonable contract has failed.

# WARRANT

---

TO VITAL CORMIER, A CONSTABLE OF THE TOWN OF VAN BUREN  
IN THE COUNTY OF AROOSTOOK AND STATE OF MAINE.

GREETING:

In the name of the State of Maine you are hereby required to notify and warn the inhabitants of the town of Van Buren qualified by law to vote in town affairs to assemble at "Dreamland Hall," so-called, in said town on Tuesday, the twenty-eighth day of March, instant, at nine o'clock in the forenoon to act upon the following articles, to act:

- Art. 1. To choose a moderator to preside at said meeting.
- Art. 2. To choose all other necessary town officers for the ensuing year.
- Art. 3. To see if the town will authorize the appointment of one or more road commissioners, not exceeding three in all.
- Art. 4. To see if the town will grant and raise such sums of money as may be necessary for the maintenance and support of schools, for the purchase of text books, repair of school houses, for the support of the poor, and the repair of roads and bridges, building and repairing of sidewalks, for the payment of the several town officers, and to defray all others town charges and contingent expenses for ensuing year.
- Art. 5. To see if the town will vote "yes" or "no" on the question of appropriating and raising money necessary to entitle the town to State aid, as provided in section 20 of chapter 130 of the Public Laws of 1913.
- Art. 6. To see if the town will appropriate and raise the sum of Six Hundred (\$600.00) dollars for the improvement of the section State aid road as outlined in the report of the State highway commission, in addition to the amounts regularly raised for the care of ways, highways and bridges; the above amount being the maximum which the town is allowed to raise under the provisions of section 19 of chapter 130 of the Public Laws of 1913.
- Art. 7. To see whether the town will vote to raise money and what sum for the maintenance of State and State aid highways during the ensuing year, within the limits

- of the town: under the provisions of sections 9 and 18 of chapter 130 of the Public Laws of 1913.
- Art. 8. To see what action the town will take with reference to providing a system of electric lights, so as to ensure the lighting of the streets of the village in the town of Van Buren, at all seasons of the year, and what sum or sums of money it will appropriate for the accomplishment of that purpose.
- Art. 9. To see if the town will vote the usual sum required to pay hydrant rental.
- Art. 10. To see what sum the town will appropriate for fire apparatus and supplies.
- Art. 11. To see what sum the town will vote to appropriate to pay the firemen
- Art. 12. To see what sum the town will vote to complete the road from the Parent road along the rear line of the river farms as far as Grand Isle town line.
- Art. 13. To see if the town will vote to appropriate a sum of money to be expended to build the road extending from the homestead farm of Ferdinand Dube to the homestead farm of Cyrille Dube, and passing along the southeasterly line of lot of land of Solime Plourd, Fred J. Parent, Carice Violette, Antoine Mosse, Ferdinand Dube and Abel B. Violette.
- Art. 14. To see if the town will vote to appropriate a sum of money to expend on the road known as the Desjardins road, which extends from the road on the rear line of the river lots and follows the north line of lots numbered sixty-nine (69) sixty-seven (67) and sixty-six (66) to the Grand Isle town line.
- Art. 15. To see what sum of money the town will vote to complete the road extending from the homestead farm of Alcide Marquis and running on the line between Lot number six (6) and lot number seven (7) to the town line between Van Buren and Cyr Plantation,
- Art. 16. To see what sum of money the town will vote to expend on the Willie Duplessis road, so-called, which extends from the rear line of the river lots to Lot numbered sixty-four in Van Buren.
- Art. 17. To see what sum of money, if any, the town will vote to expend on the road along Duperry Brook.
- Art. 18. To see if the town will vote to change the location of the school house now situated near Antoine Thibodeau's

homestead farm.

Art. 19. To see if the town will vote to employ a regular road patrolman to perform maintenance work on the state and state aid highways in Van Buren, in accordance with the provisions of chapter 272 of the Public Laws of 1915.

Art. 20. To see if the town will vote to elect a fireward or firewards for the ensuing year and what compensation the town will vote for said fireward or firewards.

Art. 21. To see if the town will vote to authorize the selectmen to borrow money on a note or notes signed by them in behalf of the town for temporary needs during the ensuing year.

Art. 22. To see if the town will vote to raise the sum of money necessary to pay interest on the town bonds.

Art. 23. To transact all other necessary business that may properly come before said meeting.

The Selectmen will be in session at the place of meeting at eight o'clock in the forenoon of the day of the meeting to revise the list of voters.
