



Warrant for Town Meeting

State of Maine County of Knox

To Hollis B. Nevells, a constable of the Town of Isle au Haut,

Greetings:

In the name of the State of Maine, you are hereby required to notify and warn the inhabitants of said Town of Isle au Haut, qualified to vote in town affairs, to assemble at Revere Memorial Hall in said Town, on Monday March 1, 1937, at nine o'clock in the forenoon, to act on the following articles, to wit:

To choose a moderator to preside at said meeting. Art. 1

Art. 2 To choose a town clerk for the ensuing year.

Art. 3 To choose a board of selectmen for the ensuing year.

To choose assessors of taxes. Art. 4

Art. 5 To choose overseers of poor.

To choose a collector of taxes, and excise tax, and Art. 6 vote his compensation.

To choose a treasurer and vote his compensation. Art. 7 Art. 8 To choose a member of the school board for three years.

Art. 9 To see if the town will vote to elect a road commissioner, one or more, fix his term of office, not to exceed three years, have the selectmen appoint, or they themselves act as commissioners, as provided by Chap. 40 of the Public Laws of 1932, or act anything relating thereto.

Art. 10 To choose a sealer of weights and measures.

Art. 11 To choose two or more constables.

Art. 12 To choose a fire warden and vote his compensation.

Art. 13 To choose surveyors of wood and lumber.

Art. 14 To see what sum *f* money the town will appropriate and raise for current expenses.

Art. 15 To see what action the town will take in regard to school for the ensuing y ear.

Art. 16 To see what sum *f* money the town will appropriate and raise for schools, including textbooks, supplies and high school tuition.

Art. 17 To see what sum of money the town will appropriate and raise for school house repairs.

Art. 18 To see what sum *f* money the town will appropriate and raise for the superintendent *f* schools' salary.

Art. 19 To see if the town will vote "Yes" or "No" on the question of appropriating and raising money necessary to entitle the town to State Aid as provided in Sect. 20, Chap. 28, R evised Statutes of 1930.

Art. 20 To see what sum the town will appropriate for State Aid R oad construction - in addition to the amounts regularly raised for the care of ways, highways and bridges - under the provisions of section 19, Chap. 28, Revised Statutes of 1930, or under the provisions of Sect. 3, Chap. 173, Public Laws of 1935.

Art. 21 To see what sum, if any, the town would recommend to take from the joint state aid account for the purpose of applying bituminus surface treatment to state aid roads, in excess of the requirements of Section 2, Chapter 132, Public Laws 1935.

Art. 22 To see what sum *f* money the town will appropriate and raise for the maintenance *f* town roads and bridges.

Art. 23 To see what sum of money the town will appropriate and raise for the repairs on State Aid roads.

Art. 24 To see what sum of money the town will appropriate and raise for the removal of snow. Art. 25 To see what sum of money the town will appropriate and raise for the maintenance of Revere Memorial Hall including insurance.

Art. 26 To see what sum of money the town will appropriate and raise to pay the debt on the new truck or act anything relating thereto.

Art. 27 To see if the town will vote to authorize the selectmen to issue notes for temporary loans.

Art. 28 To see if the town will vote a certain date, on or before which all taxes will be paid also decide on a rate *of* interest for all taxes unpaid after that date, or act anything relating thereto.

Art. 29 To act on any other business that may come before said meeting.

The selectmen hereby give notice that they will be in session, for the purpose f revising and correcting the list f voters, at Revere Memorial Hall at 9: o'clock in the forenoon, on date f said meeting.
