To the Inhabitants of the Town of Isle au Haut:

I have examined the records of the Town of Isle au Haut for the fiscal year 1941 which started Feb. 1, 1941, and ended Feb. 1, 1942. Without making a detailed audit of all transactions, I have examined or test checked the records of that period to the extent and by the methods that seemed appropriate to me.

I believe the accompanying Exhibits and Schedules to be essentially correct and certify that they were compiled from the town records.

As shown by the comparative balance sheet herewith it will be noted that the financial condition of the town improved during the fiscal year. This is evidenced by an increase in surplus of nearly a thousand dollars. This was possible by reason of unexpended balances in most accounts and by reason of income in the truck and tractor account in which the excess of receipts over maintenance was over \$350. Part of this money was used to finance the increase in wage scale in labor. It was noted that no depreciation was charged against the equipment nor was any money set aside as a sinking fund to replace it when worn out.

It was noted also that the wage bonus to road labor a-mounted to \$670.27.

The records of the town were generally well kept and understandable, and differences noted were minor. The clerk's records and the Valuation book were exceptionally neat and well kept.

The auditor wishes to thank the town officials for their courtesy and cooperation.

WARRANT FOR TOWN MEETING

To Maurice E. Barter, a constable in the Town of Isle au Haut,

Greetings:

In the name of the State of Maine, you are hereby required to notify and warn the inhabitants of said Town of Isle au Haut, qualified to vote in town affairs, to assemble at Revere Memorial Hall in said Town on Monday, March 1, 1943, at nine o'clock in the forenoon, to act on the following articles, to wit:

- Art. 1 To choose a moderator to preside at said meeting.
- Art. 2 To choose a town clerk for the ensuing year.
- Art. 3 To choose a board of selectmen for the ensuing year.
- Art. 4 To choose assessors of taxes.
- Art. 5 To choose overseers of poor.
- Art. 6 To choose a collector of taxes and excise tax and vote his compensation.
- Art. 7 To choose a treasurer and vote his compensation.
- Art. 8 To choose a member of the school board for three years.
- Art. 9 To see if the town will vote to elect a road commissioner, one or more, fix his term of office, not to exceed three years, have the selectmen appoint or they themselves act as commissioners, as provided by Chapter 40 of the Public Laws of 1933, or act anything relating thereto.

- Art. 10 To choose a sealer of weights and measures.
- Art. 11 To choose two or more constables.
- Art. 12 To choose a fire warden and vote his compensation.
- Art. 13 To choose surveyors of wood and lumber.
- Art. 14 To see what sum of money the town will appropriate and raise for current expenses.
- Art. 15 To see what sum of money the town will appropriate and raise for school, including textbooks, supplies and high school tuition.
- Art. 16 To see what sum of money the town will appropriate and raise for schoolhouse repairs.
- Art. 17 To see what sum of money the town will appropriate and raise for a school nurse.
- Art. 18 To see what sum of money the town will appropriate and raise for the salary of superintendent of schools.
- Art. 19 To see if the town will vote to give the selectmen authority to sell property taken for taxes or act anything relating thereto.
- Art. 20 To see what sum of money the town will appropriate and raise for Mothers' Aid.
- Art. 21 To see what sum of money the town will raise and appropriate for state aid road construction (in addition to the amounts regularly raised for the care of ways, highways and bridges) under the provisions of Section 19, Chapter 28, Revised Statutes of 1930, or under the provisions of Chapter 213, Public Laws of 1941.

- Art. 22 To see what sum of money the town will appropriate and raise for the maintenance of town roads and bridges.
- Art. 23 To see what sum of money the town will appropriate and raise for repairs on State Aid Roads.
- Art. 24 To see what sum of money the town will appropriate and raise for snow and ice removal.
- Art. 25 To see what sum of money the town will appropriate and raise for the maintenance of Revere Memorial Hall.
- Art. 26 To see if the town will vote to authorize the selectmen to issue notes for temporary loans, and what interest to pay.
- Art. 27 To see what sum of money the town will appropriate and raise to pay the outstanding note or act anything relating thereto.
- Art. 28 To see if the town will vote a certain date on or before which all taxes should be paid; to decide on a rate of interest for all taxes unpaid after that date; also to decide on a date before which all tax bills shall be issued.
- Art. 29 To act on any other business that may come before said meeting.

The Selectmen hereby give notice that they will be in session, for the purpose of revising and correcting the list of voters, at Revere Memorial Hall, at 9 o'clock in the forenoon, on the date of said meeting.
