

# Warrant for Annual Town Meeting

---

SOMERSET, ss.

STATE OF MAINE

To Olney Wilbur, Constable of the Town of Hartland:

GREETING:

In the name of the State of Maine you are hereby required to notify and warn the inhabitants of said Town of Hartland qualified by law to vote in town affairs to assemble at the Opera House in said town on Monday, the 12th day of March, A. D. 1934, at ten o'clock A. M. to act on the following articles, to wit:

Art. 1—To choose a moderator to preside at said meeting.

Art. 2—To choose a town clerk for the ensuing year.

Art. 3—To hear all reports to be made at said meeting.

Art. 4—To choose three or more selectmen for the year ensuing, and act upon anything relating thereto.

Art. 5—To choose three or more overseers of the poor for the ensuing year, and act upon anything relating thereto.

Art. 6—To choose three or more assessors for the year ensuing, and to act upon anything relating thereto.

Art. 7—To see if the town will vote to authorize the selectmen to appoint a road commissioner or act upon anything relating thereto.

Art. 8—To choose all necessary officers for the year ensuing, fix their compensation, and to act upon anything relating thereto.

Art. 8A—To see what sum of money the town will vote to raise: (a) for salary of school committee; (b) for salary of superintendent of schools; (c) for insurance on school buildings.

Art. 9—To choose one or more for the superintending school committee, and to act upon anything relating thereto.

Art. 10—To see what action the town will take in relation to the collection of taxes for the ensuing year, and to act upon anything relating thereto.

Art. 11—To see what sum of money the town will vote to raise for the support of common schools and to act upon anything relating thereto.

Art. 12—To see what sum of money the town will vote to raise for repair of school buildings.

Art. 13—To see if the town will vote to instruct the superintending school committee to arrange with Hartland Academy to furnish instructions to the high school pupils for the year ensuing, and to act upon anything relating thereto, and to raise such sums of money as will be necessary to furnish its pupils with free high school instruction.

Art. 14—To see if the town will vote to authorize the superintending school committee to employ a school physician and to raise a sum of money for the same.

Art. 15—To see what sum of money the town will vote to raise for music supervisor for the schools.

Art. 16—To see if the town will vote to raise \$1,500.00 as a sinking fund on our school bonds, also \$1,425.00 to pay one year's interest, and to act upon anything relating thereto.

Art. 17—To see what sum of money the town will vote to raise for town charges, and act upon anything relating thereto.

Art. 18—To see what sum of money the town will vote to raise for the support of the poor for the year ensuing, and to act upon anything relating thereto.

Art. 19—To see what sum of money the town will vote to raise to be expended on roads and bridges for the ensuing year and to act upon anything relating thereto.

Art. 20—To see what sum of money the town will vote to raise to be expended on sidewalks for the ensuing year and to act upon anything relating thereto.

Art. 21—To see what sum of money the town will vote to raise to supply deficiencies in consequences of abatements and discounts for the year ensuing and anything relating thereto.

Art. 22—To see what sum of money the town will vote to raise for memorial observances.

Art. 23—To see what sum of money the town will vote to raise for electric lights for the year ensuing and to act upon anything relating thereto.

Art. 24—To see what sum of money the town will vote to raise for cemeteries for the year ensuing and to act upon anything relating thereto.

Art. 25—To see if the town will vote "yes" or "no" on the question of appropriating and raising money necessary to entitle the town to state aid and as provided in Section 20 of Chapter 28 of the Revised Statutes of 1930.

Art. 26—To see what sum the town will appropriate and raise for the improvement of the section of state aid road as outlined in the report of the State Highway Commission (in addition to the amounts regularly raised for the care of ways, highways and bridges) under the provisions of Section 19, Chapter 28, Revised Statutes of 1930, or under the provisions of Section 3, Chapter 175, Public Laws of 1933.

Art. 27—To see if the town will vote to raise and appropriate under the provisions of Section 130 of the Public Laws of 1923 and to act upon anything relating thereto.

Art. 28—To see what sum of money the town will vote to raise for the support of Volunteer Fire Company and act upon anything relating thereto.

Art. 29—To see if the town will vote to raise the sum of \$25.00 to be paid as salary to the chief of the Volunteer Fire Company for the year ensuing and act upon anything relating thereto.

Art. 30—To see what sum of money the town will vote to raise for Hartland Free Library.

Art. 31—To see what sum of money the town will vote to raise to pay interest on interest-bearing debt.

Art. 32—To see what sum of money the town will vote to raise for water rental and to act upon anything relating thereto.

Art. 33—To see what sum of money the town will vote to raise to be expended for cutting bushes in the highway and to act upon anything relating thereto.

Art. 34—To see what sum of money the town will vote to raise for maintenance of patrol for ensuing year.

Art. 35—To see if the town will vote to authorize the selectmen to hire money, in anticipation of taxes, and to pay the town debt.

Art. 36—To see if the town will vote to raise a sum of money, if any, for fence around Rand District Cemetery in West Hartland.

Art. 37—To see if the town will vote to abate the taxes on the hospital for ensuing year, or act upon anything relating thereto.

Art. 38—To see if the town will vote not to allow the parking of cars in front of the two Miller Houses.

Art. 39—To see if the town will vote to accept the street known as Moore Street.

The selectmen will be in session at the above named Opera House one hour before said meeting for the purpose of correcting the list of voters.

## Report of Superintendent of Schools

---

To the Superintending School Committee and Citizens of Hartland:

I herewith submit my annual report of the condition and progress of your schools.

The school year closes in June while the municipal year closes in February. This results in the covering of part of two school years by the annual report which is made at this time. The spring term was completed by the same teachers as were reported in last year's summary. The year closed with a graduation of the eighth grade pupils, most of whom entered the Academy this fall.

The schools maintained, teachers, wages per week and enrollment of the current year are shown in the following table:

Comparison with last year's table will show that Mrs. Louder, Miss Pelkie and Mrs. Hogan were new teachers in the system. Miss Pelkie resigned at Fuller's Corner in the fall and Mrs. Hogan was secured to take her place. Both Mrs. Louder and Mrs. Hogan are Normal school graduates with several years successful experience. The only reason we can command their services at the low wages we pay is because they were located here for the time being and were willing to teach for what we could pay.

Music during the present year is under the supervision of Miss Gertrude Thorne, a teacher of broad training and much experience. Under her able supervision the music teaching in the grades is being better correlated and the instrumental and vocal work in the Academy is being developed successfully.

With the beginning of the fall term the children who had been attending Coston's Corner were transferred to the Village

school. This was done at a saving to the town and will give the pupils the benefit of larger graded schools.

The enrollment at the Academy for the present year has been 105 of whom 57 are Hartland residents. The teaching force remained the same until mid-year at which time Mrs. Ruth Daggett Fuller resigned and her place was taken by Miss Selah Richmond whose training and experience well fit her for her work. A readjustment of the daily program was made which has resulted in more efficient handling of the extracurricular work of the school. It is to be hoped that with the return of more prosperous days that it will be possible to enrich the course of study by the addition of some of the more practical subjects.

On February 8 the roof of the Pleasant Street school caught fire from a spark and some damage was done to the building. This will be largely covered by insurance. Temporary repairs were made and only one week of school lost. The time of the fire and prompt action by the fire department prevented a much heavier loss. I believe it would be good policy to shingle this roof with fire resisting shingles. The insurance rate would be lowered and the danger of fire from without greatly decreased.

There has been a reduction of expenditures of over \$1100 during the last year. Teachers salaries were cut and janitor service. Less was paid for high school tuition, books and music. Fuel was the only item showing any substantial increase. However, this is somewhat offset by a larger amount on hand than last year at this time.

The School Committee and Superintendent have considered carefully the probable cost of the schools for the coming year. It is believed that by continued careful economy that the schools can be maintained with the same appropriation for common schools as last year, namely, \$4,800.00. At least \$200 should be raised for repairs and \$100 for school physician. There is a sufficient balance in the music account together with what the Academy pays to carry this account for the municipal year so that it will not be necessary to raise money this year. This will reduce the total amount to be raised for common schools by \$500 over last year.

In closing I wish to commend the Selectmen and Treasurer for the efficient way in which they have financed the schools. Not a single payroll has been delayed and that is certainly a worthwhile achievement. I wish especially to express my appreciation to the teachers who, under somewhat discouraging conditions, have given their best that no child should suffer in his edu-

tional opportunity during these trying times. I trust the community may come to understand and appreciate more fully the faithful work of these public servants in whose keeping rests, to such a great extent, the future of our beloved state and nation. To all others who have contributed to the success of the schools, I am grateful.


