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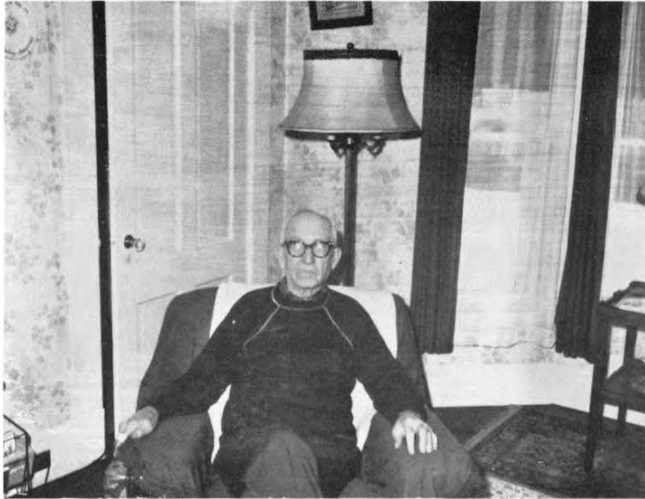

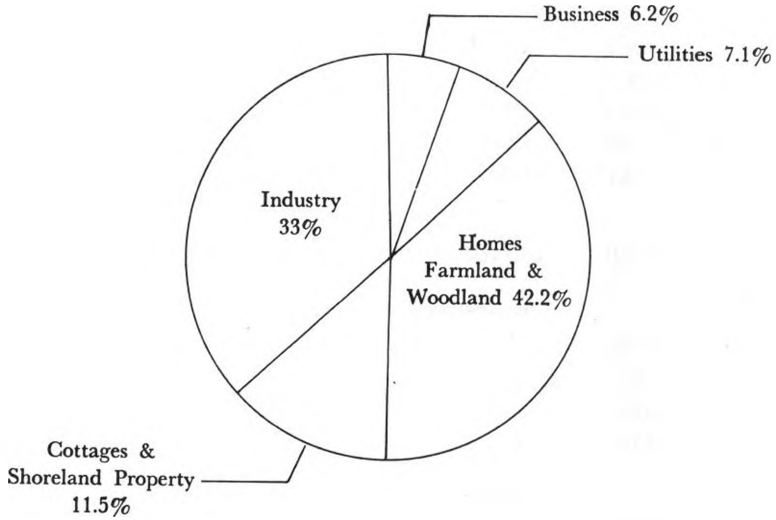

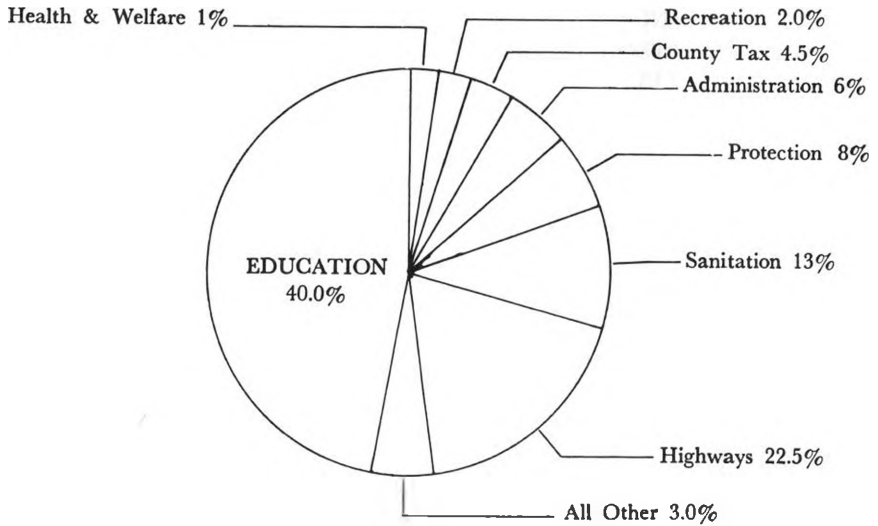

LETTER OF TRANSMITTAL

It is with pleasure that I submit to you an annual report for the year ending January 31, 1977.

This year I am pleased to report that construction at the Pollution Abatement Plant is nearly completed. The flow was started on January 3, 1977 on all sewage except the Pre-Treatment Plant at the Tannery, which should be tied in within two or three weeks. At that time the plant should be taken over by the Town.

I would like to take this opportunity to inform all the homeowners that have sewers dumping into the river, that they must make a change over to the sewer system as soon as possible after the frost is out of the ground this spring, or be subject to fines.

It is also necessary that every home owner that has a sump pump in his cellar which is connected to the sewer system will have to remove it from the system. The reason for this is that it is too costly to process surface water at the new plant. We would greatly appreciate your cooperation on this matter.

So far as I know now, the bridge between Mill Street and Bridge Street will be replaced this year, and I have been told by the D.O.T. that the Town's share will be \$14,000.

Some of the things I will recommend to the citizens this year are: to continue with more hot top surface on the Ford Hill Road and the Morrill Road and also to continue construction on Great Moose Drive.

I would recommend that sometime in the near future that there be a cement cap put onto the bridge on the Ford Hill Road.

The re-construction on State-aid road Route 23 will begin this Spring starting approximately at the Morrill Pond Fish and Game Club House and extending to the Central Maine Power right of way as far as funds will allow.

I would like to express my appreciation and give thanks to all the organizations and people that took part and assisted in our successful Bicentennial celebration.

Again it has been a pleasure to serve you and I am looking forward to serving you in the future.

ASSESSOR'S REPORT

Equity, equalization, uniformity and standardization are words that are being expressed or implied when talking of taxation and assessing at the state level, municipal and in the homes of people in Hartland. Fair share is what the taxpayer is willing to pay. In order to achieve these standards and arrive at these goals the Bureau of Taxation is working hard to provide information and set up guidelines that can be used by local assessors. This information can be used not only for uniformity and equity within the Town but also as a guide for standardization between municipalities.

Information — Facts and figures are not to be feared but to be used to keep costs of administration down by eliminating errors. Since the acquiring of the new tax maps, there were many errors made due to the change over of the new map and lot numbers. The ever-present land disputes which were not settled by the time the maps were completed continues to complicate the job of the assessors.

In September, Alfred Boudreau was hired by the Town of Hartland under the CETA program to work on our tax maps and set up a file system which will provide information to aid in an equalization program. In the maps, he has recorded the names of the owners and on the larger parcels the acreage on each map and lot. Work has also begun on errors and mistakes on boundries plus updating as new transfers and new information comes in. On the files, a new system has been set up which provides for a detailed account of land features and classes, services available, building sketches, a picture, grade and condition, add ons and deductions for functional and economic obsolescence and a continuous assessment summary. To date the pictures have been taken of the main building on each lot; the mobile homes sketched, recording the floor plan, length and width, name

(make) and age. At present he is working on the homes, sketching, measuring and grading the inside and outside. This is expected to be mostly completed by town meeting time except the measuring of the remaining homes when the snow goes off the ground. This is the first time that a record exists as comprehensive as this and is a step in the right direction.

We, the assessors and Al Boudreau want to thank Mr. Seekins the Town Manager, for his many hours of assistance in working with the problems with the tax maps and identifying properties, and especially the people for their fine cooperation in providing information and allowing inspection of their homes. We feel that as a result of this cooperative effort on the great task of equalizing the tax burden and meet the State standards required of us.

Before the completion of this re-assessment, it is the proposal of the assessors that Irving Tanning be reassessed by a certified assessor.

Exhibits and schedules incorporated in this report present the financial position of the Town at January 31, 1977, and the result of its operations for the year then ended.

TOWN OF HARTLAND

An audit has been completed of the books and records of the Town of Hartland for the year ended January 31, 1977.

The records maintained by the Town Manager, Tax Collector, Assessors and Town Clerk were audited. The system of internal control was reviewed. Accounting records and other supporting evidence were examined or tested to the extent deemed necessary under the circumstances.

It is believed that the accompanying balance sheet together with the related financial statements fairly present the financial position of the Town at January 31, 1977, and the result of its operations for the year then ended.

ASSETS

A review of the cash receipts indicated that all monies had been promptly and properly deposited in the bank in the manner prescribed by statute and the balance at the year end totaled \$42,093.59. This was reconciled as follows:

The savings account earned interest of \$2,827.66 and this was credited to the interest account.

Cash collections of \$7,982.47 were made on prior years taxes and all collections were promptly deposited in the bank. Prior years taxes totaling \$568.31 were deemed to be uncollectible and were written off. Uncollected taxes assessed against real estate in 1975 amounting to \$9,185.46 were secured by tax liens.

Cash Collections on unmatured tax liens amounted to \$8,407.58 and one piece of property represented by a matured tax lien was transferred to tax acquired property. It was noted that waivers had been obtained when partial payments had been accepted on unmatured tax liens thus protecting the Town's position. Authorization was given the Selectmen at the annual meeting to sell tax acquired property and three pieces of property were sold during the year.

State revenue sharing funds totaling \$14,893.71 were used to reduce the amount necessary to be raised by taxation. Since the actual receipts exceeded the amount used by \$367.78, this will be available to apply against the amount raised in 1977.

LIABILITIES

Tax anticipation notes totaling \$100,000 were issued and paid during the year .

RESERVES AND SURPLUS

Receipts from Federal Revenue Sharing totaled \$54,717 and this amount was deposited in a savings account in the Skowhegan Savings Bank where it earned interest of \$1,289.36 and will be available for allocation in 1977. The amount available for allocation at the 1976 annual meeting was \$52,866.48 and the entire amount was allocated. Any funds not expended from these allocations have been carried forward to the ensuing year for expenditure.

During the year the Town received \$11,988 from the Federal Government as an Anti-Recessional Fund. This was invested in certificates of deposit and must be allocated in 1977.

The Cemetery Water Fund earned interest of \$83.85 during the year and totaled \$1,715.38 at the year end. This fund is invested in a savings account in the Maine National Bank.

The Pine Grove Cemetery Fund received \$55 from the sale of lots and \$73.01 in interest on the savings account. This fund totaled \$1,544.30 at the year end and except for \$55 which was in the cash of the General Fund was invested in a savings account in the Maine National Bank.

Net unexpended balances in certain appropriation accounts carried forward to the ensuing year for expenditure totaled \$9,582.54. It should be noted that included in this net figure is an overdraft of \$9,275.03 in the SAD #48 account which should be raised by taxation next year.

The unappropriated surplus was reduced by \$6,738.39 as a result of the year's operations. The principal contributing factors to this reduction were the net overdrafts in certain of the appropriation accounts and the appropriations made at the annual meeting. Partially offsetting these were the unallocated excise taxes, the overlay and the tax reimbursement from the State. At the year end unappropriated surplus totaled \$59,572.41.

TRUST FUND

The investments of the trust funds were verified by physical inspection of the securities and bank passbooks. During the year Keyes Fibre Company had a stock split and the Cemetery Perpetual Care Funds which held 502 shares received one additional share for each two shares held or a total of 251 shares. Also during the year 30 shares of Central Maine Power Company stock was purchased. All interest received was properly accounted for and all expenditures appeared to be in accordance with the terms of the bequests. New funds totaling \$450 were accepted at the Annual Meeting and currently there are two funds totaling \$450 being held pending acceptance at the next Annual Meeting.

GENERAL

Excise tax receipts totaled \$26,902.65. Of this amount \$15,000 was allocated to Winter Roads at the last Annual Meeting and the balance was credited to surplus.

Receipts from the State for snowmobiles amounted to \$1,026 and was credited directly to surplus.

POLLUTION ABATEMENT

Work has been nearly completed on the pollution abatement project which was a joint venture in which the Federal Government, the State of Maine and the Irving Tanning Company in addition to the Town contributed the necessary funds. This will be operational very shortly.

During the year the bond issue of \$1,500,000 was retired. New notes totaling \$750,000 and \$52,300 were issued and were paid.

At the year end cash on hand totaled \$142,140.36. This was on deposit in a savings account and two checking accounts in the Maine National Bank. One checking account is for the construction account and the other for operations.

WARRANT FOR ANNUAL TOWN MEETING

To James D. Seekins, a constable in the Town of Hartland, County of Somerset.

GREETINGS:

In the name of the State of Maine, you are hereby required to notify and warn the inhabitants of the Town of Hartland in said county, qualified by law to vote in town affairs, to meet and assemble at the Hartland Town Hall in said town, Saturday, the nineteenth day of March, 1977 A.D. at 10 o'clock in the forenoon, then and there to act on the following articles:

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FROM BUREAU OF TAXATION

A new program has been established under Chapter 503, Public Laws of 1971, called "The Elderly Householders Tax Relief Act." Generally speaking, this program provides for a direct payment by the State to those resident maintaining a homestead, whether owned or rented, where at least one male member of the household is 65 years of age, or a female member is at least 62. The total income of all members of the household (including income from all sources) cannot exceed—\$4,000; and at least 35% of total household income must be attributable to the elderly members. Finally, no claimant may have more than \$30,000 of net assets.

The grant is an amount equal to 7% of the difference between total household income and \$4,000; but not in excess of the property tax on the homestead, or 20% of rent paid for the previous year.

Claims under this program are to be filed with the Bureau of Taxation. Local assessors will not be directly involved, although in many cases they may be approached initially by elderly persons asking information. Under this law, claims will first be filed (with the Bureau of Taxation) between August 1 and October 15, 1977. The Bureau will have informational material and the necessary claim forms prepared well in advance of the August 1 date, and we plan to furnish a supply to municipal officials for local distribution. In the meantime, if local taxpayers should have any further questions, please ask them to write directly to this office.

Town of Hartland

Section 706, Title 36, M.R.S.A. of the Revised Statutes states that before making an assessment, the assessors shall give reasonable notice in writing to all persons liable to taxation in the municipality to furnish the assessors true and perfect lists of their polls and all their estates not by law exempt from taxation of which were possessed on the 1st day of April of the same year. This section has been amended to read: The notice to owners may be by mail directed to the last known address of the taxpayer or by any other method that provides reasonable notice to the taxpayer.

Section 5 says that if the assessors fail to give this notice as required, the taxpayer is not barred of his right to make application for abatement.

The taxpayer should make out this list in writing and send it to the assessors or bring it in to them on or before April 1 of this year.

Any taxpayer receiving a town report with the above printed in it or receives a copy of the above section by mail is considered to have had a proper notice.

The selectmen hereby notify all taxpayers that they will be in session on the 1st day of April at the Town Office from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 a.m. to receive above mentioned lists.
