REPORT OF SELECTMEN AND TOWN MANAGER

To the Citizens of Carmel:

The Board of Selectmen and Town Manager respectfully submit the following report of activities for the year ending December 31, 1971.

- 1. Town Road Improvement: An additional section of the Five Road was re-constructed.
- 2. State Aid Construction: The money raised for 1971 will be coupled with the money raised for 1972 and a Special State Aid allotment, for more construction on the Hinckley Hill Road this year.
- 3. Cutting Bushes: During 1971, bushes were cut on sections of Ash Hill Road, Fuller Road and Bemis Road.
- 4. Town Dump: As usual Douglas Small has done a fine job in taking care of the dump, however, due to increased use (and abuse) of dumping privileges, a change has been made in the method of payment. We are now paying on an hourly basis, plus the cost of gravel and eradication.
- 5. Town Road Tar: Tar was applied to the Fuller Road from Damascus to the Irish Road. Hot Top was applied on Church Street and to a section of the Fuller Road near Damascus Bridge.
- 6. Salt and Sand: An additional 500 yards of sand was added to what was left over last year giving us about 1200 yards in all.
- 7. Cemeteries: This past summer, we were fortunate in having two high school boys do most of the mowing and taking care of our four cemeteries. They also did some painting and cleaning at the Town Office and the Fire Station. Their services were paid for through th Neighborhood Youth Corp. Erral Preble worked with them as supervisor.

8. Town Roads and Bridges: About \$2,000.00 was spent in patching the Town tar roads. Two 18" culverts and one 30" culvert were replaced on the Bemis Road. Also, the lower end of Bemis Road was ditched and gravel hauled in.

The Town Office is open Monday, Wednesday and Friday from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., on Tuesday and Thursday from 9:00 to 12:00 a.m., and on Monday evening from 7:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m.

The Selectmen meet at the town office Monday evenings at 7:30 pm. We welcome your suggestions for the good of the Town.

CARMEL VOLUNTEER FIRE DEPARTMENT

To the Citizens of Carmel:

During 1971 this department was called out a total of 25 times. Of this number, 5 were house fires, 5 chimney fires, 6 grass fires, 5 calls to the dump, 2 car fires, and 2 false alarms. Three calls were from the Town of Etna.

This year we purchased \$1,400.00 worth of much needed equipment; five hundred feet of one and one-half inch hose (\$800.00), new foam equipment to modernize the department (\$350.00), 20 lb. Dry Powder fire extinguisher Dry Powder, CO₂ Cylinders, Hose Adapters, Pike Poles, Axe Handles and miscellaneous equipment (\$250.00).

Through the response of the area people and the hard work of this department, we realized \$ from the Fireman's Ball.

At this time, I would like to acknowledge the help from mutual aid of Hermon and Levant Fire Departments, also, the help of the Junior Fire Department. Without their help and enthusiastic response, the work of this department would have been greatly handicapped.

This year the ambulance service is being reorganized as the Carmel Volunteer Ambulance Service. Volunteers are needed as ambulance attendants, drivers, and general help for the care and maintenance of the equipment. Also needed are babysitters for those nurses who respond to calls.

Eventually, the ambulance will be operated under a mutual aid agreement with Hermon, Levant and Glenburn. There are plans for purchasing a four channel shortwave radio which will be used in conjunction with the three hospitals in the Bangor area and mutual aid as the Penobscot Valley Rescue Association.

SCOPE OF AUDIT

The system of internal control was reviewed as it pertained to the handling of cash and other matters of financial concern. Cash accounts were verified by reconciliation of bank statements and/or bank confirmation.

An analysis was made of receipts and deposits as well as disbursements and bank charges. Vouchers, payrolls and cancelled checks were examined on a selective basis. Letters of confirmation were used on a test basis to verify the correctness of recorded assets and liabilities.

Revenue accruing to the municipality from various sources was reviewed and checked to pertinent records. Records of town and selectmen's meetings, as they pertained to financial matters, were checked. Trust and reserve fund transactions were reviewed and investments verified. Surety bond coverage was determined.

COMMENTS OPERATIONAL RESULTS

The fiscal year's operations showed that a net unexpended departmental balance of \$13,884.20 was lapsed to the unappropriated surplus, per the following summary:

The balance of excise tax revenue, the overlay, and unexpended balances in the contingent, welfare and tax interest accounts were the major factors contributing to the amount lapsed to surplus.

The following comments pertain to the accompanying financial statements:

ASSETS . . . The general fund cash balance totaled \$62,706.88 at the year end. The bank balances used in reconciling this amount were confirmed by the depositories. Petty cash was counted.

Accounts receivable of \$547.95 consisted of amounts due from the State and other municipalities for welfare disbursements.

Taxes receivable totaled \$20,888.23 of which \$20,195.04 represented current year accounts. The remaining balance of \$693.19 was for unpaid accounts dating from 1965. Tax liens and tax acquired property amounted to \$6,772.13 and \$2,394.95 respectively.

LIABILITIES, RESERVES AND SURPLUS . . . The departmental accounts showed an unexpected balance of \$9,722.78 carried forward to the ensuing year in accordance with customary practice and/or pending further activity.

Other reserves included trust funds being held pending acceptance and tax acquired property rentals which are to be applied to future property purchases.

The unappropriated surplus amounted to \$81,830.76, an increase of \$18,698.11 for the year. This change was occasioned principally by the net unexpended departmental balance lapsed, the income on investments, the investment of the ministerial and school fund, and an adjustment to the reserve for tax losses.

TRUST AND RESERVE FUNDS . . . Trust fund principals totaled \$12,497.71 and unexpended income was \$1,185.29.

At the annual town meeting the townspeople voted to establish a fire department capital reserve fund and a credit reserve fund. All trust and reserve funds are on deposit in the Bangor Savings Bank, Bangor, Maine.

GENERAL

The use of excise tax revenue to supplement appropriations by taxation for specific current year operations was authorized by the voters.


