At the request of the Selectmen, I am submitting a very brief summary of the condition, needs and progress of the schools of your town.

Teachers and pupils have been tremendously hampered throughout the year because of a lack of proper facilities, such as text books and other necessary supplies with which to work. A high standard of work cannot be expected under such handicaps. In spite of the difficulties offered, all teachers have displayed a splendid spirit of cooperation, patience, loyalty and tolerance.

The minimum number of weeks as required by law have been maintained in both the elementary and high schools.

Following is the present enrollment: High School 54; Grammar School 32; Hamlin Intermediate 26; Hamlin Primary 33; Central 29; Tabbutt 15; Total 189. Regular promotions were made at the close of the year in June. Number of elementary pupils promoted to high school, 11; number of high school pupils graduated, 12; number of non-resident pupils registered in high school, 16.

Attendance has been somewhat irregular during the winter months because of some of the pupils not being provided with suitable clothing and because of the prevailing epidemic of measles.

Salaries of the high school principal and assistant were reduced from \$27.78 and \$20.00 to \$23.00 and \$15.00 per week, respectively. Salaries of teachers in the Grammar, Intermediate, Primary and Tibbetts Town schools were reduced from \$15.00 to \$10.00 and salaries of the principal and assistant in the Central school were reduced from \$13.00 and \$12.00 to \$9.00 and \$8.00 respectively.

The Central building was painted throughout at a cost of \$161.99. Shingles have been purchased for the roof of this building and will be used in the spring, presumably. The foundation of this building will have to be rebuilt this year.

Considerable work in the nature of painting and repairing needs to be done to the Tibbetts Town building.

While the success of a school system cannot be efficiently measured in a day or even a year, I feel that the general progress made in the schools during the past year, in spite of the low financial support accorded, is encouraging.

In closing this brief report, I want to thank the Superintending School Committee and Teachers for their continued support and cooperation. To the citizens who have remained loyal to the schools of Columbia Falls, allow me to convey my sincere regard for your help and interest. May you ever keep the child first in your midst. May you exalt him above road building, above politics, above industry, above all the petty sel-

fish things that weaken and destroy the human race. The future progress of the children of your town, yea, the future progress of the town itself, is now in your hands.
