While the foregoing budget calls for an expenditure of \$654.83 more than for the last municipal year the recommended appropriation is the same.

As a result of an increase in the equalization fund of \$793.00 over last year it has been possible and necessary to increase the elementary school year to 36 weeks.

The high and elementary school account shows an unexpended balance of \$521.58. Since a definite minimum school program has been set up by the State, under the provisions of the regulations governing the allocation of the equalization fund to the various towns, any unexpended balance resulting therefrom cannot be used to reduce appropriations if the town is to continue to share in this fund.

The repairs account shows an unexpended balance of \$173.36. This amount should have been spent for painting the High and Hamlin School rooms. The recommended appropriation for repairs is \$200.00. This increase in the repairs account is recommended with the idea in mind of taking care of the painting heretofore mentioned and repairing the shed and toilets at the Hamlin and Central schools.

Enrollment in the various schools is as follows: Village Grammar 17; Intermediate 21; Primary 18; Central Grammar 16; Central Primary 12; Tabbutt 14; High School 49; Total 147.

Of the number enrolled in the High School twelve are tuition students, nine from Columbia and three from Centerville.

No changes were made in the teaching personell during the past year. The work of the teachers has been commendable and the proficiency made by the pupils commensurate to the facilities offered.

I acknowledge, in closing, the untiring efforts of the teachers and the support and cooperation of the Superintending School Committee, for which I am truly grateful.
