We have had 25 weeks school in each district for the school year past. The spring term at High Head was taught by Miss Mabel Wilson of Castine. Whole number of scholars attending 12; average attendance 11. Fall term was taught by Kenneth Bragdon of Sullivan. Whole number of scholars attending 15; average attendance 10. The spring and fall term at Cove school was taught by Mrs. Effie Baker of Sullivan. The whole number of scholars attending spring term 8; average attendance 7. Whole number attending fall term 7; average attendance 6 34-100. The teachers gave good satisfaction and the scholars made good progress. Cove school having failed to maintain an average attendance of 8 pupils is suspended according to Section 2, school laws of Maine, and if this school is to be maintained

the coming year it will be necessary for the Town to instruct the superintending school committee to maintain said school.

## Copy of Warrant

### STATE OF MAINE.

HANCOCK, ss.

To I. W. Nash, a constable of the Town of Sorrento,  
Greeting :

In the name of the State of Maine, you are hereby required to notify and warn the inhabitants of the Town of Sorrento qualified by law to vote in Town affairs to meet at High Head schoolhouse in said Town on Monday the sixth day of March A. D., 1905, at ten o'clock in the forenoon to act on the following articles, to wit :

- Art. 1—To choose a moderator to preside at said meeting.
- Art. 2—To choose a town clerk for the ensuing year.
- Art. 3—To hear report of Town officers and act thereon.
- Art. 4—To choose selectmen for the ensuing year.
- Art. 5—To choose assessors of taxes.
- Art. 6—To choose overseers of poor.
- Art. 7—To choose a road commissioner.
- Art. 8—To choose a town treasurer for the ensuing year.
- Art. 9—To choose a collector of taxes.
- Art. 10—To choose members of superintending school committee.
- Art. 11—To choose a town auditor.
- Art. 12—To choose constables.
- Art. 13—To choose truant officers.
- Art. 14—To choose a harbor master.
- Art. 15—To choose surveyors of lumber, wood and bark.
- Art. 16—To choose all other necessary Town officers.
- Art. 17—To fix compensation of treasurer and collector.

Art. 18—To see if the Town will vote what discount shall be allowed on taxes and for what time.

Art. 19—To see if the Town will vote to authorize the selectmen to sell the property that the Town holds by tax deeds.

Art. 20—To raise money for common schools.

Art. 21—To raise money for insurance and repairs of school property.

Art. 22—To raise money for text books.

Art. 23—To raise money for the support of poor.

Art. 24—To raise money for repairing roads and bridges.

Art. 25—To raise money for sidewalks.

Art. 26—To raise money to pay tuition for high school scholars.

Art. 27—To raise money for current and contingent expenses.

Art. 28—To raise money for Memorial Day.

Art. 29—To see if the Town will vote to maintain two schools.

Art. 30—To hear report of committee in regard to building a Town hall and schoolhouse, and raising money for same.

Art. 31—To see if the Town will vote to charge interest on taxes unpaid after a certain date, the per cent. and date to be designated by vote of Town.

The selectmen will be in session at High Head schoolhouse on the sixth day of March next, at nine o'clock in the forenoon for the purpose of correcting the list of voters. Given under our hands this 20th day of February A. D., 1905.
