ARTICLE 2. **LEASE OF LAND TO HISTORICAL SOCIETY TO CONSTRUCT HISTORICAL BARN:** To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Board of Selectmen to enter into a lease with the New Gloucester Historical Society at minimal cost, and upon terms as determined to be reasonable by the Board of Selectmen, to construct a Historical Barn to house the Tenant's collection of artifacts and papers for safe storage and display. The site is located behind the Town Hall, known as the "stable" that is to be demolished by the Tenant.
