TOWN OF NEW GLOUCESTER MINUTES OF SPECIAL TOWN MEETING June 21, 2010

The moderator asked for a vote by show of hands on the motion to allow Nancy Pinette to speak. The raise of hands was not unanimous. The moderator asked for a ballot vote by voter check-off and a yes vote of 2/3 of the voters. Yes votes -71 – No votes 24. Nancy Pinette was allowed to speak.

end the debate.

Vote: A show of hands showed motion carries.

Motion: Bradford Slye moved and Katherine Slye seconded a motion to

vote by paper ballot.

Vote: A show of hands showed motion failed.

Motion: Stephen Hathorne asked to move the question. Melanie Craig

seconded the motion.

Vote: The vote on the amendment failed 29-yes and 49-no. Vote: It was voted that Article 4 have passage at \$74,512.
