Gold Frogs

This motif draws on Precolumbian design traditions in which double-headed frogs were cast in gold, made in clay, and painted on pottery vessels. Frogs were associated with fertility and were considered to be sacred. Today the Golden Frog (*Atelopus zeteki*) has become a national symbol of Panama.
