How do I return books to the library while it's closed?

If you have a book nearing its due date, please note that we are **extending all due dates to September** automatically. If public health concerns require us to extend that due date further, we will do so.

With that in mind, here are some basic guidelines for returning books to Fogler Library while it is closed due to the COVID-19 pandemic:

1. Books borrowed directly from Fogler: If you intend to be on campus in the fall, you may keep books until you return to campus. Due dates will be extended accordingly.
2. Books borrowed from Fogler via another library: Community patrons who borrow Fogler materials via another library are encouraged to return our materials to their home library after it reopens.
3. If necessary, you may return books at any time using the book return slots at Fogler Library or by mailing the books to
