University of Maine System COVID Data by Campus

22 — Known Case of UMS students or employees in public health agency isolation among the more than 30,000 students, faculty, and staff in the University of Maine System community.

The University of Maine System has now completed the Fall 2020 semester. These data would include university students or employees known to have an active case of COVID-19 but not necessarily living in the campus region or state.

The above Data reflects ACTIVE known cases identified through the UMS asymptomatic screening and other testing venues. When an individual is released from an isolation order by a public health agency the active case number shared in the Together for Maine daily update is reduced to reflect that change. UMS is reporting 22 known cases today, 8 cases fewer than the cases reported in the [12/18/20 update](#).

- None of the active cases are residential students;

Asymptomatic Screening Update for Fall Safe Return

- 39,603 Test Results to Date
- 120 positive results representing new diagnoses of COVID-19

The Asymptomatic Screening Dashboard at [Together.Maine.edu](#) represents known results on all asymptomatic tests going back to July 22, 2020. About 48 hours passes from the time a test sample is collected and when the results are known. Limited testing is continuing with the University's in-person population greatly reduced with the transition to distance instruction.
