All health and safety protocols are in effect on UMaine and UMM campuses, and in our facilities and offices statewide, including wearing face coverings indoors and out, and maintaining 6 feet of social distancing.

Students and employees who have been on campus or on-site in university facilities this semester will continue to participate in weekly COVID-19 testing. At this time, testing is still required of all who are on-site, even after being vaccinated. Those vaccinated must wear face coverings and maintain social distancing. While highly effective, vaccination does not guarantee that a person will not contract or spread the virus.

Employees who have been working remotely should continue to do so unless advised otherwise by supervisors.
