Do students and employees who are fully vaccinated have to quarantine if they are a close contact with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19?

Asymptomatic students, staff and faculty who would otherwise be required to participate in asymptomatic COVID-19 testing, which currently involves weekly testing, and who otherwise would be required to quarantine when determined to be a close contact of a positive COVID-19 case, may be exempted from testing and quarantining if they are fully vaccinated and provide verification of their fully vaccinated status to the university.
