May 9–23, the maximum indoor gathering limit will be up to 50% of permitted occupancy, with five persons per 1,000 square feet, or 50 persons, whichever is greatest and which allows for 6-foot physical distancing. The maximum outdoor gathering limit will be up to 75% of permitted occupancy that allows for 6-foot distancing. Beginning May 24, the maximum indoor gathering limit will increase to up to 75% of permitted occupancy that allows for 6-foot distancing, and maximum outdoor gathering limit will be up to 100% permitted occupancy that allows for 6-foot distancing. As circumstances warrant, and based on EOC recommendations, we may limit group gatherings on campus or for particular university events or gatherings to lower levels.
