UMaine's COVID-19 asymptomatic T3 saliva testing runs through Dec. 16. The testing location is the ballroom on the first floor of Estabrooke Hall.

All UMaine and UMaine Machias students and employees, regardless of vaccination status, are encouraged to participate in weekly campus-based asymptomatic COVID-19 testing. Please schedule appointments Monday–Thursday via [PointnClick](#).

Those required to participate in weekly testing schedule their test appointment days and times every week via [PointnClick](#).

For any university community members who are symptomatic, please seek a test at Cutler Health Center or from your primary care physician.
