## What is the schedule for on-campus asymptomatic COVID-19 testing during winter break, starting Dec. 20, for those required to test and those who are fully vaccinated and opting to test?

Asymptomatic Shield T3 COVID-19 saliva testing continues on campus through winter break, providing weekly testing for community members required to do so. All UMaine students and employees, regardless of vaccination status, are encouraged to participate in campus-based asymptomatic COVID-19 testing.

Hours are 8:30 a.m.–5 p.m. on Mondays and 6:30 a.m.–5 p.m. on Wednesdays. Please schedule appointments via [PointnClick](#) and bring your MaineCard to your testing appointment.

Test results are typically available within 24 hours.

**Note: The two days of weekly testing will require participants, especially international travelers, to plan accordingly.**
