## Will students have to participate in COVID-19 testing weekly until they are eligible to receive their booster shots?

As of Feb. 1, students who are on-site and have not yet received their COVID-19 booster shots will participate in weekly COVID-19 testing on campus.

The exceptions from weekly testing are students [who have submitted either the online form reporting a positive test result](#) or have a T3 on-campus positive test result. They will be exempt for 90 days from the positive test date before being required to resume testing.

[According to the CDC](#), booster shots can be administered at least 5 months after the second dose of the Moderna or Pfizer vaccines, or at least 2 months after receiving the single dose of Johnson & Johnson vaccine.
