Maine-made cloth face coverings and other consumer products

[CDC recommends](#) wearing cloth face coverings in public settings where other social distancing measures are difficult to maintain (e.g., grocery stores and pharmacies), **especially** in areas of significant community-based transmission. **Effective May 1, 2020, face masks are required in such public settings in Maine.**
