Option 1: Using Single Sign-on

Single sign-on makes it easier to access Fogler Library electronic resources—including journals, indexes, and databases—when you are not on campus. Simply sign in to your [myUMainePortal](#) account and navigate to Library subscription resources by clicking on the Fogler Library icon on the myCampus LaunchPad.

Option 2: Use the URSUS Proxy Bookmarklet

The Ursus Libraries Proxy Bookmarklet allows you to quickly and easily access restricted journal articles and ebooks discovered on a publisher's website while conducting research on the open internet.
