University of Maine System COVID Data by Campus

110 — Known Case of UMS students or employees in public health agency isolation among the more than 30,000 students, faculty, and staff in the University of Maine System community.

- 101 UMaine: Seven new cases
 - Four new cases involving non-residential students
 - Three new cases involving residential students
- 3 UMA:
 - One student completes isolation
 - One new case involving a non-residential student
- 4 UMF:

- 0 UMM: One student completes isolation
- 0 UMPI: Three students complete isolation
- 2 USM: One student completes isolation

The above Data reflects ACTIVE known cases identified through the UMS asymptomatic screening and other testing venues. When an individual is released from an isolation order by a public health agency the active case number shared in the Together for Maine daily update is reduced to reflect that change. UMS is reporting 108 known cases today, six cases more than the cases reported in the [11/26/20 update](#).

Asymptomatic Screening Update for Fall Safe Return

- 38,076 Test Results to Date
- 101 positive results representing new diagnoses of COVID-19

The Asymptomatic Screening Dashboard at [Together Maine.edu](#) represents known results on all asymptomatic tests going back to July 22, 2020. About 48 hours passes from the time a test sample is collected and when the results are known.
