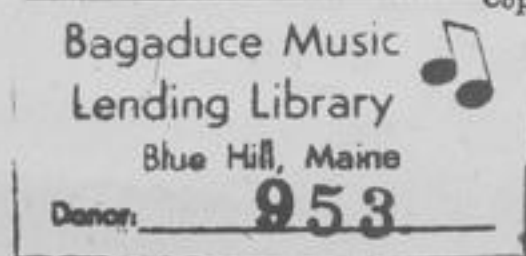

The piano introduction is in 3/4 time, key of B-flat major. It begins with a melody in the right hand and a supporting bass line in the left hand.
