INTRODUCTION
Moderato

The Introduction is written for piano in G major, 2/4 time. It consists of two systems of music. The first system has a treble staff with a melody of eighth and sixteenth notes and a bass staff with a simple accompaniment. 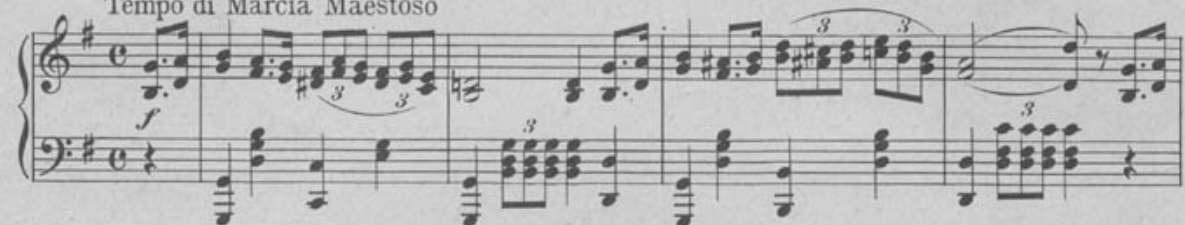

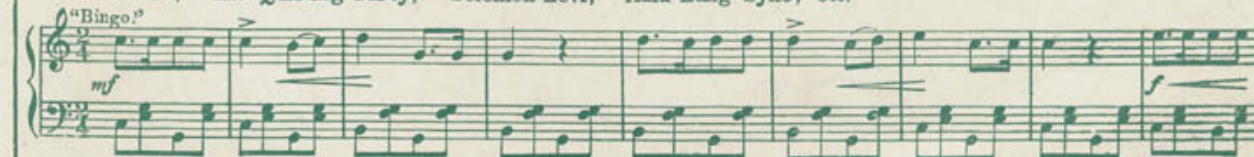
